Impact of Supreme Court's DOMA Ruling on Employers and Their Benefit Plans

Please join us as our speaker, William B. Duff, Partner with Schiff Hardin LLP discusses the Supreme Court's DOMA ruling, captioned U.S. v. Windsor. What are the immediate implications for employers that sponsor retirement, health and welfare, and fringe benefit plans?

- Plan sponsors may need to make changes to their employee benefit plans to recognize same-sex spouses in the same manner that such plans recognize spouses of the opposite sex.
- Employers also need to examine, among other things, their payroll systems and practices as well as Family and Medical Leave Act (FMLA) policies to determine if changes are necessary as a result of the DOMA ruling.
- Specific steps that sponsors of retirement and health plans should take now in light of the Court's ruling.
- Key operational and compliance issues that are currently unresolved, but about which plan sponsors should be aware.
